Visitor Safety Precautions

- Encourage guests with pre-existing conditions to suspend visitation temporarily due to their increased COVID-19 risk
- If you are feeling ill, or displaying any symptoms linked to COVID-19, please refrain from visiting to ensure the safety of our other guests
- Maintain social distancing as much as possible
 - There will be ample signage to direct our guests where to check-in for kayak rentals, along with designated spots to stand while waiting in line to maintain proper distancing.
 - We will be encouraging guests to call ahead or book online to avoid unnecessary interaction during the check-in process.
 - After check-in, guests will be directed via signs to the waterfront where their kayak is located



Sanitizing & Cleaning Procedures

- All Kama'aina Kids employees will be wearing masks and sanitizing their hands in-between customers
- There will be hand cleaning stations (hand sanitizer dispensers and/or sinks) available to all guests
- All rental equipment- snorkeling gear, dry bags, coolers, anchors, lifejackets, paddles- will be sanitized thoroughly after each use and not reused
- All kayaks will be cleaned and sanitized after each use



Our Current Operations

- Our Kayak and Hobie Catamaran tours will be operating in a limited capacity- primarily to family groups, etc. that ensure proper social distancing is maintained
- Transportation will be offered for tours but in a limited capacity
- Lunch is suspended temporarily for all tours
- Kayak/Hobie Catamaran Rentals will have modified procedures that ensure proper sanitation and distancing procedures are maintained
